Moreover, when it comes to exams, we find that the questions are really much more difficult than what we were getting in the quizzes through out the semester.
Taught in the same order as Professor Badawi taught it.

1) The material explained in the classroom is similar to the quiz provided; HOWEVER, the questions asked on the midterms and finals were not similar AT ALL to the material explained in class.
2) The structure of the questions asked in class and in quizzes does not match the structure of questions asked on midterms AT ALL.
3) I believe that the professor should explain why linear algebra would ever be needed in real life by providing word problems, as for now, I personally have no idea where I could apply what I have learned from linear algebra.
