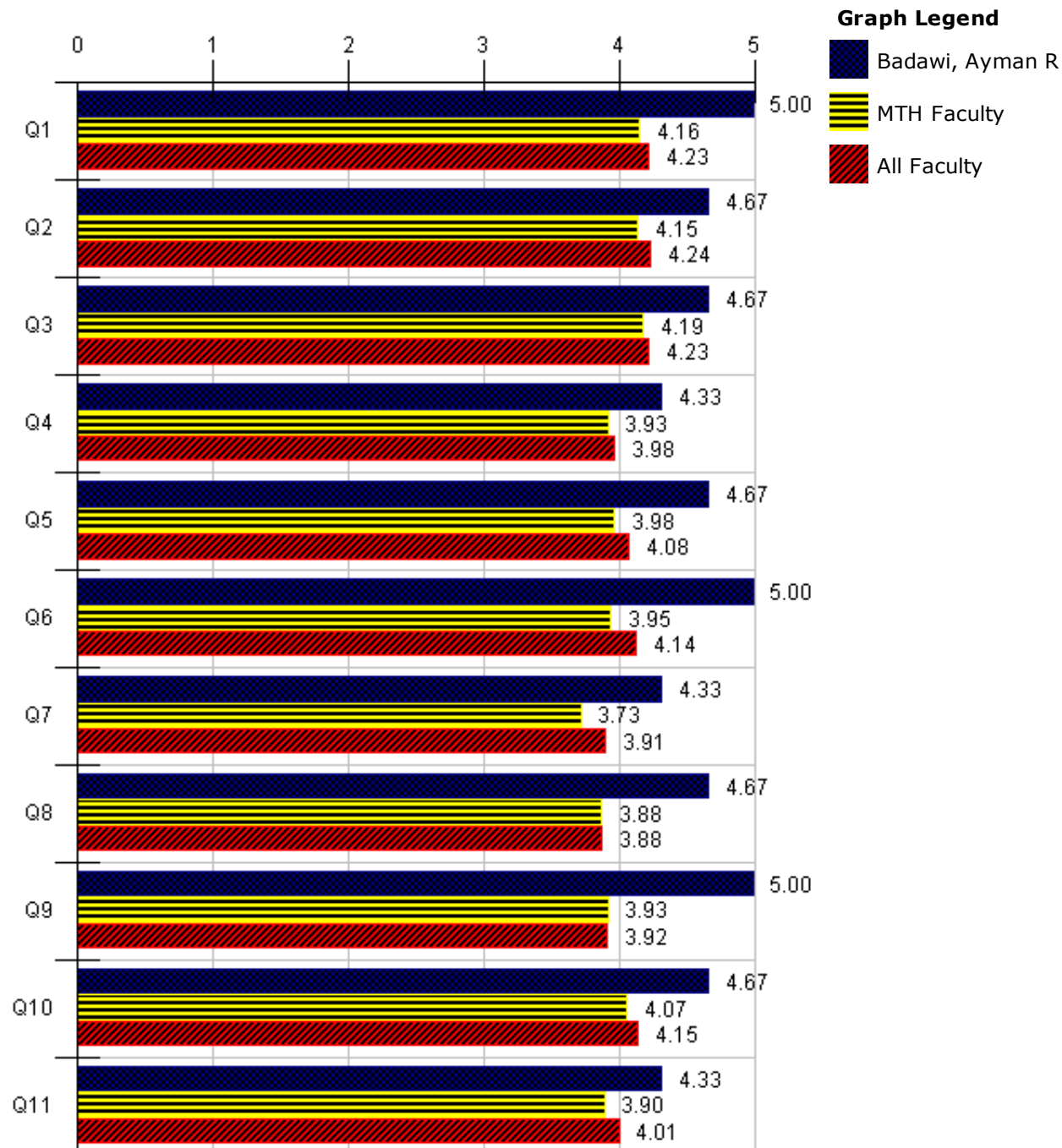

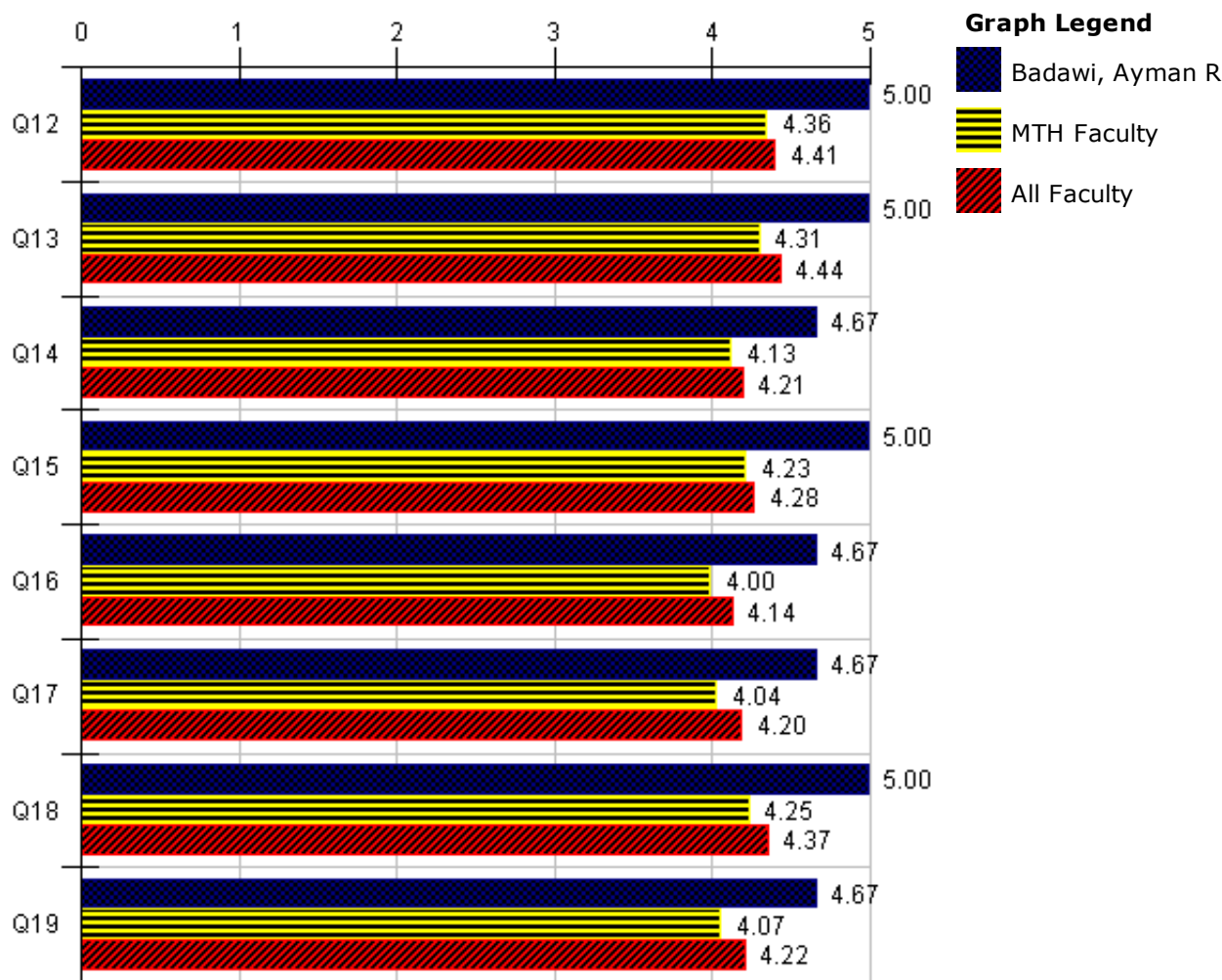

- It is a brilliantly taught course and covering material that every graduate student should know.
- I think Dr Ayman taught it incredibly well; of course I have taken linear algebra as an undergraduate but I didn't remember much of it. I think he introduced all the material in a beautiful and comprehensive fashion making the experience very interesting for both the novice and experienced graduate student; that is in fact the surprising thing about his lectures they cater to every level of ability; I suppose in the language of education that would be mean the instruction is highly differentiated.
- Also the emphasis is on critical ideas and the methods of proof utilized exhibited are very beautiful and very aesthetically appealing. Moreover the focus is on covering critical ideas and not proof every proposition which frankly isn't pragmatic given the time constraints. The coverage of material was really good and I think we covered the Jordan form and part of the rational canonical form
